Project Timeline

2011 Moratorium lifted on creation of nursing homes for residents transitioning from State care.

February 2012 DMHAS (Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services) issues Request for Proposal for “Nursing Home for Individuals in State Care Who Are Difficult to Place.”

June 2012 iCare awarded RFP for “Nursing Home for Individuals in State Care Who are Difficult to Place.”

2012 Commissioner of Correction granted additional release mechanism for individuals with chronic, debilitated conditions, or in need of end of life care.

November 2012 SecureCare Realty LLC purchases facility in Rocky Hill, CT.

May 2, 2013 60 West licensed by Department of Public Health. First resident admitted.

December 5, 2016 60 West is issued a federal Medicare provider number.
